
FOREWORD

MOU FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SHRI BADRINATH DHAM AS A SPIRITUAL SMART HILL TOWN

Top oil and gas PSUs of India, including Indian oil, BPCL HPCL, ONGC and GAIL, have inked for construction and Redevelopment of Shri Badrinath Dham in Uttarakhand as a Spiritual Smart hill Town

These PSGC will contribute Rs. 99.60 crore in Phase I., that will include developmental activities.

RAFAL NADAL CLINCHES 12TH BARCELONA OPEN TITLE

Rafael Nadal beat Stefanos Tsitsipas 6-4, 6-7, 7-5 to win his 12th Barcelona Open title. It was Nadal's

87th career title, and his 61st title on clay. This is the second tournament where Nadal has captured 12 or more titles. The 13-time Roland Garros champion will return to No. 2 in the FedEx ATP Rankings.

NUWAN ZOYSA BANNED FOR 6 YEARS FOR BREACHING ICC's ANTI CORRUPTION CODE

Former Sri Lanka player and coach, Nuwan Zoysa has been banned from all cricket for six years after an ICC Anti-Corruption Tribunal found him guilty of breaching the ICC anti-corruption code. The ban for Zoysa is backdated to 31 October 2018, when he was provisionally suspended.

IPL 2021: AUSTRALIAN PLAYERS SET TRAVELS TO THE MALDIVES:

Australian cricketers participating in the IPL will leave for the Maldives by chartered plane, where they will wait for the Australian border to open. Australian players who were in India for IPL are enroute to the Maldives. Australian cricketers will stay there amid travel ban to their country. Cricket Australia and the Australian Cricketers' Association on Thursday confirmed that the Australian players, coaches, match officials and commentators have been safely transported from India and are en route to the Maldives. The Australians will remain in the Maldives until the conclusion of the travel pause pertaining to flights from India to Australia.

RAVINDER BUDDY SINGH, MOSCOW OLYMPICS GOLD AWARD VICTOR WITH INDIAN HOCKEY GROUP, KICKS THE BUCKET OF CORONAVIRUS:

Fomer India hockey player Ravinder Buddy Singh passed on of Coronavirus on Saturday. Ravinder was important for the Indian group that won Gold at 1980 Olympics . He was conceded to emergency clinic in Lucknow on April 24 in the wake of getting Coronavirus. Ravinder had been fighting Coronavirus for about fourteen days and inhaled his rearward in Lucknow. He had been conceded to the Vivekananda Emergency clinic on April 24 in the wake of getting the infection. Alongside winning the gold at 1980 Games, Ravinder likewise played at 1984 Los Angeles Olympics and 1979 Junior World Cup.

INDIA EXPECTED TO DECLARE LARGE CREW FOR BRITAIN TRIP, PRITHVI SHAW SET FOR REBOUND:

The Indian team is scheduled to play the World Test Championship final against New Zealand at Southampton from June 18-22 before taking on England in a five-Test series. The Indian group is booked to play the World Test Title last against New Zealand at Southampton from June 18-22 preceding taking on Britain in a five-Test arrangement.

The arrangement will begin at Nottingham (Aug 4-8) and will be trailed by matches at Ruler's (August 12-16), Leeds (Aug 25-29), Oval (Sep 2-6) and Manchester (Sep 10-14). The security of each individual engaged with the IPL was one of the significant explanations behind the BCCI and the IPL Overseeing Gathering to collectively settle on the deferment of the alliance on Tuesday.

MAN FLOODED WITH OBSCENE CALLS AFTER HIS PHONE NUMBER IS DISPLAYED IN A FILM

The makers of Tollywood star Pawan Kalyan's latest film Vakeel Saab have caused a great trouble for a man after his phone number was displayed in the movie. The number was flashed without his permission in a scene that shows a few miscreants morphing Anjali's picture and circulating her contact number on the internet. She finally gets obscene phone calls from unknown men in the film, just what the Ameerpet resident Sudhakar faced. He has now started a legal proceeding against the makers of Vakeel Saab.

He said he has been receiving these upsetting calls from the onset of the release of the film in April which led to affect his mental health.

Vakeel Saab which is the remake of Pink, released in theatres on 09/04/2021 to packed houses. The film, however suffered a setback as the second wave of coronavirus intensified. Later, its theatrical run was cut short and the filmmakers released it on Amazon Prime Video by the end of April.

TWO ARRESTED IN MUMBAI IN POSSESSION WITH 7KG OF NATURAL URANIUM WORTH RS. 21 CRORES

The Maharashtra Anti-Terrorism Squad (ATS) has arrested two men with 7kg of natural uranium worth Rs. 21 crores in Mumbai. Uranium is considered a rare element and is highly radioactive. It is used for making nuclear explosives.

The ATS team had received information that the accused were searching for a potential buyer to sell such huge quantity of uranium. So, a trap was laid and the two were arrested. They have been identified as Jigar Jayesh Pandya and Abu Tahir Afzal Hussain Choudhary.

The seized uranium was sent to the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre at Trombay for analysis. The report received from the research centre mentioned that the substance was natural uranium, which is "highly radioactive and dangerous to human life".

KERALA VACCINATED ALMOST 1 LAKH MORE CITIZENS THAN AVAILABLE DOSES

Amid the current shortage of Covid-19 vaccines, wastage of the crucial doses has been a matter of concern in many states. Kerala has been one of the few states which has reported a 'zero wastage' of Covid-19 vaccines so far.

One vial or a bottle of the vaccine has enough doses to give the jabs to 10 people, with one extra as a 'wastage factor'. Usually, this is lost between the 10 doses that are taken from the one single vial, but in Kerala, the Chief Minister said that they have been able to vaccinate 11 people from one vial. They were able to deliver the vaccine with such care that the state currently has a stock of 2.4 lakh vaccine doses, which only lasts a maximum of two days.

'OUT OF CONTROL' CHINESE ROCKET DEBRIS TO CRASH INTO EARTH THIS WEEKEND

Debris from a large Chinese rocket is going to hit the earth surface very soon, according to a CNN report. The 'out of control' debris will enter the earth's atmosphere this weekend.

Most of the debris burns up in the earth's atmosphere before having the chance to crash into its surface but at times, pieces of a large object may hit the earth.

THIRD PHASE OF COVID IS INEVITABLE; LET'S PREPARE FOR NEW WAVES

A third phase of the deadly novel coronavirus pandemic is inevitable, claimed K Vijay Raghavan, the Principal Scientific Advisor to the Government of India on 05/05/2021.

Addressing a press conference, Raghavan said, "A third wave is almost inevitable given the higher levels of circulating virus in the country. However, it is not clear on what time scale this phase three will occur. We should prepare for new waves." ANI quoted him as saying.

Shedding light on the transmission of the new strains of the infection he said, "Variants are transmitted same as original strain."
